RESOLUTION
OF THE POLITICAL CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE
OF THE WARSAW TREATY MEMBER-STATES

Having reviewed the letter of January 15, 1965 from the Council of Ministers of the People's Republic of Albania, the Political Consultative Committee finds that the People's Republic of Albania is avoiding participation in the work of the Warsaw Treaty.

Under such circumstances, the question of the further involvement of the People's Republic of Albania in the activities of the Warsaw Treaty depends upon the decision of the government of the People's Republic of Albania, to which no preconditions apply. The Political Consultative Committee expects the government of the People's Republic of Albania to inform the member-states of the Warsaw Treaty of its decision regarding this issue.
