14 – 15 May 1980 Agreed paragraph concerning Afghanistan

The members of the Council also underlined the necessity to normalize the situation that has arisen concerning Afghanistan politically. Such a regulation should effectively guarantee the total cessation and prevent the resurgence of any form of interference from outside directed against the government and the people of Afghanistan. Together with the total cessation of any form of interference from abroad directed against the government and the people of Afghanistan, the withdrawal of the Soviet armies from Afghanistan should take place in accordance with the affirmations of the USSR.
